Wylie: 911, what's your emergency?

Bevely: Hi, this is Julia Bevely. Came over there and someone broke in to my house.

Wylie: Okay, okay listen, calm down. What is? Listen, listen to me. Calm down. What's your address?

Bevely: 11304 Songbird Road in Marion, Illinois.

Wylie: Okay, okay listen. You said 1304 Songbird?

Bevely: 11304

Wylie: Okay. You said someone had broken in to your house?

Bevely: Somebody broke in. I just they were running out as I was coming home.

Wylie: Okay.

Bevely: And my step-daughter I think she's dead.

Wylie: Okay listen. Listen to me. Take a breath, I can't understand what you're saying. Okay? You said someone came running out of your house?

Bevely: Yeah like they were running out whenever I got home and my front door was open.

Wylie: Okay. Which way did they go?

Bevely: I don't know, they just ran out. I saw the blood and I came in to check on Jade.

Wylie: Okay, stay on the line with me here, okay? You said 11304 Songbird, right?

Bevely: Yeah.

Wylie: Okay.

Wylie to County: County, Marion.

County Dispatch: Go ahead.

Wylie: Get somebody to 11304 Songbird, 11304 Songbird. RP says she came home, saw someone running from the residence (unintelligible). Go ahead and have them (unintelligible) by there. I'm not sure what's going on but I think there's going to be injuries.

County: County, Marion (unintelligible)

Wylie: Okay, what is your name?

Bevely: My name is Julia.

Wylie: Joy? Okay, okay Joy who else is in the residence?

County: 11304 Songbird. (unintelligible)

Bevely: It's just me right now but Jade (unintelligible) dead in the bathtub. She's got multiple wounds all over her.

Wylie: Okay. Who is it that's in the bathtub?

Bevely: It's my step-daughter.

Wylie: Okay, how old is she?

Bevely: She's 11.

Wylie: Okay, is she awake?

Bevely: No I don't think so. She's not moving.

Wylie: Okay hold on. When that person left, did they leave in a vehicle or on foot?

Bevely: They were on foot. They just took off running.

Wylie: Okay. Could you tell if it was a male or a female?

Bevely: It was a male.

Unknown: (unintelligible) stand by for just a second.

Wylie: Could you tell what color shirt he was wearing?

Bevely: He was in all black.

Wylie: Okay.

Wylie dispatching: That's fine, roll an ambulance to stage.

Wylie: Okay Joy, I've got plenty of people coming to help you, okay? Where, are you still in the house or did you go outside?

Bevely: No, yeah, I'm still inside.

Wylie: Okay. Joy, what is your last name?

Bevely: Bevely.

Wylie: Do you know if anybody else was supposed to have been at the residence?

Bevely: No, nobody was.

Unknown: Williamson County Ambulance please be in route to 11304 Songbird Road, 11304 Songbird Road. Deputies are in route. Again stage in the area. Time out 12:29

Wylie: Okay. Joy, what is your middle initial and your date of birth?

Bevely: Um E um, um, um 4-23-91

Unknown: Unknown at this time, not breathing.

Wylie: I'm going to give you their phone number, give them a call by phone 993-3019. Anybody available to respond to a call for County? 11304 Songbird, 11304 Songbird. I have an 11 year old, multiple wounds, possible not breathing. Step-mother just came in from outside. 10-4. When mother came home she advised she saw someone fleeing from the residence believed to be a male subject wearing all black. Not sure where he has gone to. 11304 Songbird, 11304 Songbird.

Wylie to Bevely: Okay, we've got an ambulance coming and I've got Marion and County officers coming to you also. Okay?

Bevely: Okay

Wylie: Have you heard any vehicles or anything that might've started up?

Bevely: No I

Wylie: Okay

Bevely: I ran to town to go to the store and then I came back and that's when I saw the door was open.

Wylie: Okay, okay. As you were coming to you said you saw them running from the house. When you were facing the house, did they run towards, off towards the left or towards the right?

Bevely: I don't know.

Wylie: Okay.

Bevely: I don't know

Wylie: Okay

Unknown: (unintelligible) 11 year old not breathing. 10-4 (unintelligible) ran out of the house. Mother went inside and found child unresponsive, multiple wounds, possibly not breathing. Williamson County Ambulance (unintelligible) in the area.

Unknown: We'll be in route

Unknown: I'll take one more unit with me.

Wylie: Okay. Trying to look on my map here make sure we're going, trying to see if I can see anything else out in that area.

Unknown: (unintelligible)

Wylie: You said she's 11, is that correct?

Bevely: Uh huh

Wylie: Okay.

Unknown: (unintelligible) time out 12:32. United 11 is in route. (unintelligible)

Wylie: I think it's going to be faster if you go down Pittsburg Road. Yeah you can get there the same, 10-4.

Unknown: (unintelligible) we do have one, I don't know. (unintelligible)

Wylie: Actually if you can go to Khoury League and I'd say that's about as quick either way. (unintelligible)

Unknown: (unintelligible)

Wylie to Bevely: Okay, I've got some that are on Khoury League and I've got some that are coming from Pittsburg Road so I'm just letting you know, okay?

Bevely: Okay

Wylie: 13 go ahead and start heading towards this call too if you're not already. You'll probably need a K-9 for this. Male subject fled residence. Have a child inside residence, multiple wounds.

Unknown: Description of subject or anything that he's wearing?

Wylie: I have a male subject, dark clothes. She is not sure which direction he went, she's pretty hysterical right now.

Unknown: (unintelligible radio traffic)

Wylie: 10-4

Unknown: (unintelligible)

Unknown: 10-4 (unintelligible radio traffic)

Wylie to Bevely: Okay looks like he's just right down the road from you now.

Bevely: Okay

Marion Officer: Marion, do you have your RP on the phone? Are they still not breathing or just unresponsive?

Wylie: She does not know. She has told me that's all I've got so far.

Wylie to Bevely: Okay, there's an officer should be pulling in.

Wylie: 25, 10-4.

Bevely: She's in the bathtub. No

Wylie: Okay Joy, I'm going to let you talk to them, okay?

Bevely: Okay
